## Defining the Clinical Skills Competition

The Clinical Skills Competition provides pharmacy students with the opportunity to apply their didactic education and clinical knowledge in an interactive, team-based analysis of clinical scenarios for health-system pharmacist, including but not limited to a particular practice setting, disease state or type of drug therapy.

## Defining the Role of the Local Coordinator

The role of the Local Coordinator is vital to the success of the Clinical Skills Competition, facilitating the date, time, arena, promotion and turnout for the program.

## Defining the Main Responsibilities of the Local Coordinator

The main responsibilities of the Local Coordinator in the Clinical Skills Competition includes but is not limited to:

- Complete online **Report Form A by July 15<sup>th</sup>** to report Local Coordinator
- Schedule date, time and place for Local Clinical Skills Competition, to be held by November 1<sup>st</sup>
- Recruit panel of judges for Local Clinical Skills Competition
- Promote Local Clinical Skills Competition
- Facilitate and oversee Local Clinical Skills Competition
- Complete online **Report Form B by November 1<sup>st</sup>** to report winners of the Local Clinical Skills Competition
- Prepare winners to participate in the National Clinical Skills Competition
