REPORT ON THE VIRTUAL HOUSE OF DELEGATES

November 7-14, 2025

RESULTS OF THE VOTING

Between November 7 and 14, the ASHP House of Delegates (roster attached as an Appendix) voted on four policy recommendations. Delegates approved three policy recommendations by 85% or more, the threshold for final approval. One policy recommendation did not receive 85% of the votes and will be considered by the House in 2026.

POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS APPROVED

The three policy recommendations **approved** are as follows (percentage of delegates voting to approve follows the policy title):

Safe Technology Implementation and Expansion of Pharmacist Services (91.3%)

To promote the use of automation and technology with the goal of enabling the pharmacy workforce to dedicate more time to patient care; further,

To affirm the essential role of the pharmacy workforce in the evaluation, implementation, and ongoing assessment of all technology that impacts the medication-use process.

Note: This policy will supersede ASHP policy 1020.

Health Care Quality Standards and Pharmacy Services (91.8%)

To advocate that health care quality improvement programs adopt standard quality measures that are developed with the involvement of the pharmacy workforce, are evidence-based, and promote the demonstrated role of the pharmacy workforce in improving patient outcomes.

ASHP Statement on the Pharmacist’s Role in Substance Use Disorder Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery (95.7%)

POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS NOT APPROVED

The House **voted to not approve** the following one policy recommendation (percentage of delegates voting to approve follows the policy title):

Tobacco, Tobacco Products, and Non-Tobacco Nicotine Delivery Systems (84.0%)

To discourage the use of tobacco, tobacco products, and non-tobacco-nicotine (NTN) delivery systems due to their long-term adverse health effects; further,

To oppose the distribution and sale of tobacco, tobacco products, and NTN delivery systems by pharmacies or facilities that contain a pharmacy; further,

To advocate for tobacco-free environments in hospitals and health systems; further,

To promote legislation that supports pharmacist prescriptive authority for tobacco-cessation medications; further,

To promote the pharmacist’s interprofessional role in tobacco-cessation counseling and comprehensive medication management; further,

To join with other interested organizations in statements and expressions of opposition to the use of tobacco, tobacco products, and NTN delivery systems; further,

To support the FDA as the authoritative regulating body of these products; further,

To educate the public and patients on the risks of nicotine consumption through traditional and NTN delivery systems.
