Autoverification occurs when a medication is entered and released, bypassing the pharmacist verification step, and is automatically verified in the EHR. Another term for autoverification may be “risk-stratified assisted verification.” The SOPIT/SICP SAG on Medication Safety Autoverification Task Force would like to present the tool kit that was developed for ASHP membership for consideration when implementing autoverification.
