

## ASHP Accreditation Fee Schedule for Retail Chain-based Pharmacy Technician Training Programs

- The ASHP fee schedule is based on the calendar year (January December). Fees are invoiced annually in November for the subsequent calendar year and due within 30 days of receipt of invoice.
- Annual accreditation fees for new programs are assessed from the date of ASHP's receipt of the application for the initial calendar year
  - Example 1: Initial new program application received in April will be invoiced for threefourths of the applicable annual assessment rate
  - Example 2: Initial new program application received in June will be invoiced for one-half of the applicable annual assessment rate
- Each new program is assessed an initial application fee once the new program application has been approved and the program has been fully added to the database. This fee is due within 30 days of receipt of the invoice.
- Accreditation survey expenses are included in the annual assessment—there are no additional fees assessed during the year of a program's accreditation survey.
- The Annual Assessment Fee and Application Fee are subject to change yearly. Annual assessment fees and application fees are nonrefundable.

The accreditation fee structure is based upon the number of retail outlets/stores owned or operated by the organization since this affects the potential volume of pharmacy technicians who would be trained in the program.
