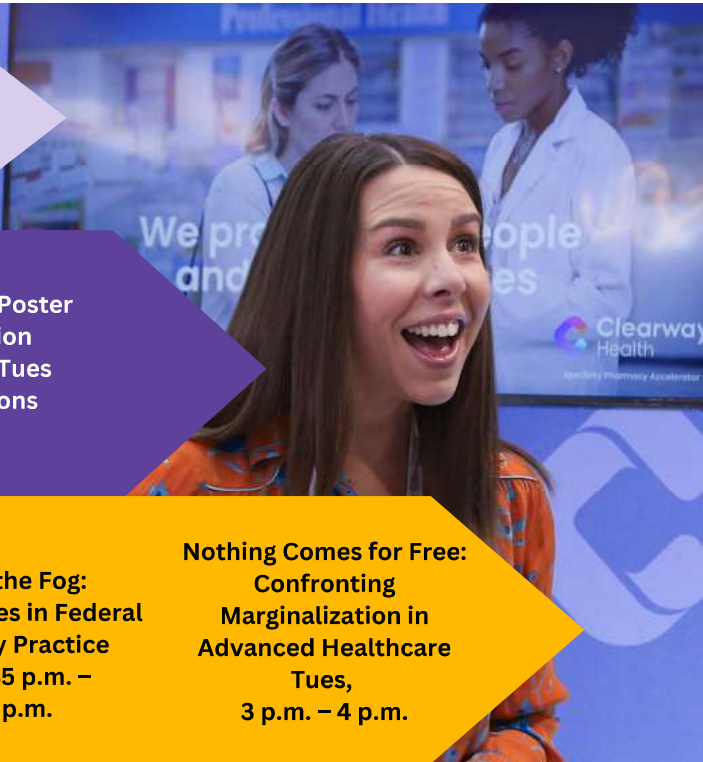

- **What is the closest airport to the New Orleans Ernest N. Morial Convention Center?**

Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport is 15 miles from the convention center. New this year for preregistered attendees and exhibitors, ASHP will host a satellite registration area at the airport!

- **Is there special hotel information for students?**
